

GRANT GUIDELINES

The grant will bring direct benefit to Great Aycliffe.

The organisation should be based within the Great Aycliffe area and at least 50% of its members or participants must come from the Great Aycliffe area.

The people or person applying for grant should live within the Great Aycliffe area.

An individual may apply but each case will be considered on its merits.

Any application for an individual should be supported by a letter from an organisation or school confirming the activity that the funds are being requested for.

You will be requested to come and tell the Youth Council about your grant request.

Grants will usually be awarded to groups or organisations, who should be a registered charity or not for profit.

Grant applicants must provide details of the efforts they have undertaken so far to raise money themselves.

Grant applicants must provide details of the amount requested.

Grant applicants must provide details of what the grant money will be used for.

Grant applicants will, wherever possible, provide bank accounts or statements in support of their application.

A report back to the Youth Council is required stating what the money was spent on and if it was to attend a competition or tournament, how they did.
