

*‘That in the event of the new Boundary Commission proposals for Parliamentary Constituencies for 2017 being approved by Parliament, we would want the name of the Constituency changed from Billingham and Sedgfield to Aycliffe and Billingham. This would more adequately reflect on the importance of Aycliffe in the new constituency, politically, industrially and geographically. Demographically and historically Aycliffe has more importance than Sedgfield in the Constituency name.
