The Neighbourhood Plan can influence land and business use. It is a planning document which will make it easier for developers to bring business and developments to the town and make Aycliffe Greater.

National and Local Planning policies require any retailer or investors to look at any town centre location first to see if their needs could be met there. If there are no suitable facilities within the town centre or nearby, then and only then can they look to any sort of out of town provision.
