

Weighboll 1900d The Great Aycliffe Neighbourhood Plan received to the recently held a resounding vote of approval in the recently held referendum, with more than 90% of the 2789 residents

who voted voting in favour of introducing new planning policies specifically for the parish of Great Aycliffe.

The official result was:

Number in favour of Yes - 2540 | Number in favour of No - 244 During a long consultation process, the residents of the parish identified their priorities for inclusion in the Plan and, as a result, it includes a number of policies that aim to protect the character of Great Aycliffe, particularly its green and open environment and its individual neighbourhoods, including an area of separation between the town and Aycliffe Village. It also aims to secure a high standard of future development and ensure that an adequate amount of affordable housing is provided, as well as properties for older people and adequate parking provision.

# **Fun Learning at** St Oswald's **Pre-School**








St Oswald's Pre-School has had a makeover, both inside and outside, and the children have been enjoying exploring the new features while having lots of fun and learning new things.

New planting areas have been built in the outdoor area and the children have wasted no time in planting lots of flowers and growing their own vegetables - not to mention checking out the wildlife, including a very inquisitive snail! The area now also has a mud kitchen, a large sandpit, construction blocks, water troughs and imaginative play sections for the children to try out new experiences and develop their interests.





Because the Pre-School is located within St Oswald's Park, the children have been able to explore the park and all its facilities and enjoy nature walks and exciting treasure hunts.

The inside of the Pre-School has also been re-arranged to allow the children to focus on their creative interests, while still allowing them to explore new areas.

Before the end of term, the children will be going on an outing to Hall Hill Farm and the school year finishes with a graduation ceremony when the oldest children will be leaving to go to primary school.
