

# Oakleaf Golf Club Local Rules

## 1 Out of bounds (Rule 18)

- a) Beyond any of the fences or walls forming the course boundaries.
- b) Beyond the fences enclosing the driving range situated to the left side of the 1<sup>st</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> holes.
- c) On or over the line of white posts on the right side of the 1<sup>st</sup> hole.
- d) Beyond the line of white posts situated to the left side of the 6<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> holes.
- e) Beyond the line of white posts situated to the rear of the 6<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> holes.

## 2 Water Hazards/Penalty Areas (Rule 17)

- a) Ordinary water hazards are indicated by yellow posts or defined by yellow lines (Rule 17-1a-17-1b).
- b) Lateral water hazards are indicated by red posts or defined by red lines (Rule 17-1b).

## 3 Abnormal Course Conditions (Rule 16)

- a) All artificially surfaced roads and paths and their sides are immovable obstructions (Rule 16-1).
- b) Relief for embedded ball in general area (Rule 16-3a).
- c) Relief is not allowed for embedded ball in sand or in general area not cut to fairway height or less (Rule 16-3b).
- d) Relief from immovable obstructions is obtained under Rule (16-1).

## 4 Ground Under Repair

- a) All areas identified by white lines or marked G.U.R. (Rule 16-1b).
- b) All areas identified by blue posts or lines are G.U.R. from which play is prohibited. If a ball lies in such an area, or if an area interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing the player MUST take relief as provided in (Rule 16-1).
- c) Deep ruts, not mere indentations, caused by course machinery, through the green are G.R.U. and (Rule 16-1) applies.

## 5 Bunkers (Rule 12)

- a) Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions (Rule 12-2a).
- b) Restrictions on touching sand (Rule 12-2b).

## Course Rules

Please replace all divots, smooth out bunkers and keep bags and trolleys off the greens and tees.

Please do not try to retrieve golf balls from inside the driving range and surrounding gardens.

All players must have a bag of clubs each.

All players should play without delay.

No more than 4 players per match.

Players MUST give way to greenkeeping staff.

Dress code must be followed at all times.
