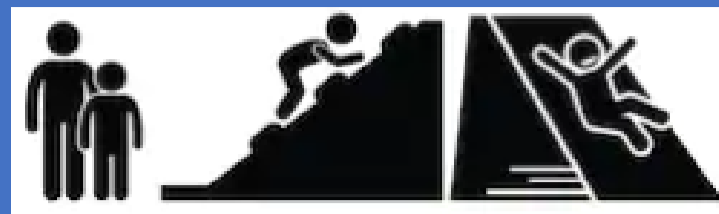


Covid-19 Government Advice & Guidance for Play Areas

Parental supervision is required for under 14's when using the play equipment.



Hands to be washed prior and after using equipment, either using wash facilities where available, or personal hand sanitizer.

Social distancing rules **MUST** be followed by all users from different households and/or family groups.



Users should avoid touching their eyes, nose and mouth while using the play equipment.

Users **MUST** not enter the play area or use any of the equipment if showing any of the following symptoms: -

- A new or persistent, continuous cough,
- Tightness in the chest, wheezing or breathlessness,
- High temperature or fever,
- Loss or change to your sense of smell or taste,

Or, if anyone from their household is showing any of the above symptoms, suspects they may have Covid-19 or it has been confirmed they currently have Covid-19.

IF THE PLAY AREA IS BUSY USERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO RETURN LATER OR FIND AN ALTERNATIVE PLAY AREA.
