PUBLIC NOTICE – MEMBERS’ ALLOWANCES

Notice is hereby given that, at a meeting of the Policy and Resources Committee of Great Aycliffe Town Council, held on 6th March 2019, members considered the recommendations of the Independent Remuneration Panel, established by members of Durham County Council in respect of parish members’ allowances, made in accordance with the:

Local Authorities (Members’ Allowances) (England) Regulations 2003

The Independent Remuneration Panel recommended the following Parish Basic Allowance for Parish and Town Councillors within County Durham:

Population	Amount Suggested by Independent Remuneration Panel
Population of 15,000 and over	10% of the county basic allowance up to a maximum of £1,330
Population between 10,000 and 15,000	7.5% of the county basic allowance up to a maximum of £1,000
Population between 5,000 and 10,000	5% of the county basic allowance up to a maximum of £665
Population between 3,000 and 5,000	2% of the county basic allowance up to a maximum of £270
Population between 2,000 and 3,000	1.5% of the county basic allowance up to a maximum of £200
Population between 1,000 and 2,000	1% of the county basic allowance up to maximum of £135
Population of under 1,000	0.5% of the county basic allowance up to a maximum of £65

The recommendations as applied to Great Aycliffe Town Council are:

Population of 15,000 and over: 10% of the County Council Basic Allowance, up to a maximum of £1,330.

The Policy and Resources Committee recommended that Town Councillors’ Parish Basic Allowance should be increased from £1,060 to £1,330 per annum as recommended.

The recommendations regarding travel and subsistence allowances were accepted.

These recommendations from the Policy and Resources Committee were subsequently ratified at the Council meeting held on 13th March 2019.
