Non-Parishioner Cemeteries Fees Exemptions

Non-parishioners will be charged at the above non-residents rates with the following exemptions: -

- 1) The deceased was the owner (or the spouse of the owner) of the grave (held Exclusive right of burial) and was a resident when the purchase was made.
- 2) Death occurred within 12 months of the deceased moving out of the Parish.
- 3) The deceased has moved to receive appropriate nursing care for the persons needs which is not available in the Parish.
- 4) The deceased was a serving member of the Armed Forces living in temporary accommodation, whose parents are still residents of the Parish.
